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PLEASE READ THROUGH ALL OF THE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLING TO FAMILIARIZE YOURSELF WITH EACH STEP.

NO TOOLS NEEDED

INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1.

Snap the plastic securing piece to the flap of the Route Bag, as shown in (Illus A).

STEP 2.

Lift the edge of the deck carpeting up behind the seat on which the Route Bag will be installed. Slide the plastic piece under the carpet and matting so it rests on top of the hard board, (Illus B).

STEP 3.

From inside the car make sure the Route Bag is centered behind the seat, (Illus C).

STEP 4.

Position the Route Bag as desired. Next use 2 small pieces of masking tape to mark the location of the plastic piece for repositioning, (Illus D).

STEP 5.

Pull the plastic piece back out from under the carpet and remove the film covering the adhesive part of the hard Velcro. Leave this part of the hard Velcro attached to the soft Velcro, (Illus E).

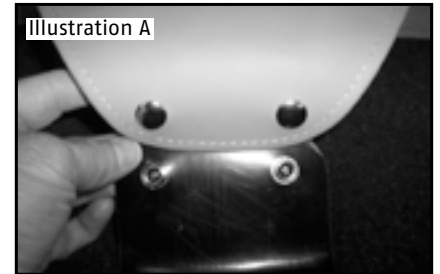
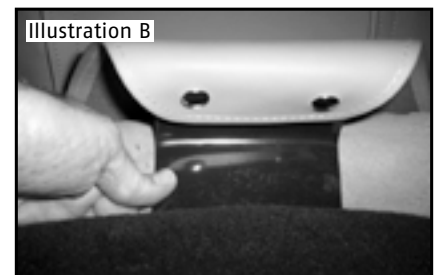

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Description (cont.)

STEP 6.

Slide the plastic piece back under the carpet. Make sure the sticky adhesive DOES NOT make contact with the hard board until you have the plastic piece centered within your pieces of masking tape. When you have it in position and against the riser wall, then stick down to the hard board and remove your masking tape. The hard part of the Velcro will stay stuck to the hard board even if you remove the plastic piece.

STEP 7.

At this point your Route Bag is in place and ready for your trip. It can be left in place all the time, as it is a great place to store your Mid America Motorworks catalog, travel maps, papers, etc. for everyday use.

STEP 8.

Removal of your new Route Bag can be done in two ways. For Cleaning or vacuuming you can unsnap the flap and leave the plastic piece in place, or simply reach under the carpet and separate the two Velcro's for complete removal. For complete removal: leave the hard part of the Velcro stuck to the hard board; remove Bag and plastic piece, unsnap the plastic piece and store it inside the Bag.

CLEANING:

The exterior of the Route Bag can be kept looking like new with leather cleaner and conditioner. The interior can be wiped out with a damp cloth.
